Role Purpose

The purpose of this role is to act as a Facilities Team Leader in the area of our Nursery operations.

1. This hands on role is to ensure the Nursery Operations facilities are maintained at an optimum, minimizing downtime, ensuring an efficient operation with a focus on plant health and employee safety.

Where applicable ensure job sheets / SOPs are used for tasks, and the team have been trained / instructed correctly and are adhering to the SOP/Job Sheets. Make sure all equipment required is in good order, calibrated if required and available prior to operations commencing. Ensure processes are completed in a timely manner with a focus on ensuring we deliver on time, on quality, in specification, and on KPI. Be an active hands on member of the facilities team. 		
Nursery Operations	30%	 As directed by the Facilities Supervisor assist in the upkeep and maintenance of all plant, equipment, buildings, environmental control systems, roadways, utility services etc As directed by the Facilities Supervisor assist in carrying out inspections of the facilities to identify and advise issues. Keep the production facility tidy and presentable. Ensure Hygiene standards are maintained at optimum levels at all times, and strictly adhere to standard operating procedures Ensure machinery is operated in a safe manner and according to the companies Health and Safety standards As part of the Nursery team you are encouraged to learn about the industry we work in and bring forward ideas that may improve the way we do things. Play a hands-on role in Nursery projects and activities, as directed by the Facilities Supervisor.
